Call for papers

We plan to hold a conference in autumn of 2024 organized by the University for Continuing Conservation Krems and the European Research Centre for Book and Paper Conservation-Restoration in celebration of the co-operation between UWK and ISI Yogyakarta and the 70th anniversary of diplomatic relationship between Austria and Indonesia.

The Conference and the book subsequently coming after it will tell the story of how the chair of conservation of movable cultural heritage at ISI Yogyakarta came into existence, will give testimony on how it all started in 1979 by Kartika and Patricia Engel becoming co-students, then in 2014 continued with a request by Kartika Affandi and Kartika bringing in ISI Yogyakarta and finally the big support by Asea Uninet and University for Continuing Education Krems. We welcome papers which contribute to the history to be told here.

The second half of the conference and the book will be dedicated to papers holding new research results. We welcome any original paper on any aspect of cultural heritage preservation, be it of philosophic, historic, legal, linguistic, theoretic or a scientific content. Also papers about practical conservation measure and new and substantial literature survey on one of the topics is welcome.

Even if we encourage the delivery of papers dealing with any Cultural Heritage property, in case a decision must be made for one of two papers we should underline that preference is given to such papers, which deal with written cultural heritage, which includes puppets.
